Taylor Miller currently serves as the Executive Pastor of Broadview Baptist Church in Abilene, TX. In this role, he regularly preaches, oversees the staff, small groups, mission trips, and directs the biblical counseling ministry.

Taylor is tremendously blessed to be married to Emily, whom he met when she came to Abilene to complete her nursing degree through the Texas Tech Health and Science Center. They have been married since 2019.

His twelve years of ministry experience began when a small church in Oklahoma asked him to serve as their student minister during the last two years of his undergraduate degree at OBU. He then joined the staff at Broadview as the student minister in December of 2016 and grew into his current position.

Taylor completed a Master of Divinity degree from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in 2021 and is currently completing a Doctor of Ministry degree in biblical counseling from The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, which he expects to complete in May of 2027.

Taylor was saved at the age of eleven at the Riverbend Retreat Center in Glen Rose. The very next year, he felt called to ministry during worship at a youth camp. In that moment, God touched his heart and impressed upon him the weightiness of the gospel and God's love.
